Withdrawals

Registrants may withdraw from a WordShop without penalty until Oct. 14. From Oct. 15 through Oct. 21, if a registrant finds it necessary to withdraw from a WordShop for which they have registered, there will be a \$15 withdrawal fee. (This fee will be waived if the registrant transfers to another WordShop.) Withdrawals after Oct. 21 will not receive a refund. Failure to attend a WordShop or verbal notification to the instructor will not be regarded as an official notice of withdrawal.

Class Cancellations

LBF reserves the right to cancel or reschedule WordShops to adjust for enrollment. If it is necessary to cancel a WordShop, all registered participants will be informed immediately and, when possible, will be offered the opportunity to register in an alternative WordShop. If participants enrolled in a canceled WordShop do not wish to transfer, a full refund will be made.
